## MINUTES OF THE LEE MPO BICYCLE PEDESTRIAN COORDINATING COMMITTEE

Held on September 27, 2016

The meeting of the Bicycle Pedestrian Coordinating Committee was held on Tuesday, September 27, 2016, beginning at 10:00 a.m. in Room A of the Fort Myers Regional Library, 1651 Lee Street, Fort Myers, FL.

Others in attendance included Ron Gogoi and Don Scott with the Lee County MPO; Sarah Larsen with Lee County Planning; Thomas McGlohon with Lee County Schools; and Mitchell Marinack with SRTS Lee County.

#### Call to Order and Roll Call of BPCC Meeting

Mr. Moser, BPCC Chair, called the meeting to order at 10:00 a.m. Quorum was met. The members introduced themselves.

There were no public comments.

### Agenda Item #1 - Approval of the August 23, 2016 BPCC Meeting Minutes

Mr. Gogoi called out one change to the August 23, 2016 Meeting Minutes to reflect that Isobel Hitchcock, and not David Wagley, had seconded the SR 82 motion.

Motion by David Wheaton to approve the August 23<sup>rd</sup> meeting minutes. Seconded by Carl Karakos. Motion passed unanimously.

### Agenda Item #2 - Amendment of the Lee-Collier Bi-County Regional Pathway Map

Mr. Scott reported that at the March 18<sup>th</sup> 2016 meeting, the Lee County MPO Board amended the Regional Pathways Map consistent with the recommendations of the Lee MPO's Bicycle Pedestrian Coordinating Committee (BPCC) and Collier MPO's Pedestrian Advisory Committee (PAC) from their joint meeting on February 23<sup>rd</sup>.

The map never got amended by Collier MPO Board as both staff and the PAC, and Collier County Transportation Planning staff felt that the map (which will be available to the public) should be made as simple as possible by showing the entire network in a single color without actually showing status of individual segments (as there were questions and inconsistencies between what is considered programmed, planned and how that is being interpreted by the staff, public and users of the system).

On July 22<sup>nd</sup>, staff from Lee and Collier MPO, and Collier County Transportation Planning met to resolve the issues, and it was proposed that (1) we show the network in a single color (2) change the title from Pathway to "Non-Motorized" Network as right of way constraints in certain urban areas within the network would not allow accommodation of new shared use paths and that the existing sidewalks have to be maintained, and (3) maintain separate maps for staff and committees' use that illustrate the status of individual segments in the network.

Motion by Sean Gibbons to amend the Lee-Collier Bi-County Regional Pathways Map. Seconded by David Saxton. Motion passed unanimously.

### <u>Agenda Item #3 - Q&A Session and Identification of Project Proposals for SRTS Infrastructure</u> <u>Funds</u>

Mr. Gogoi presented the questions that Lee County and MPO staff had given FDOT regarding project implementation and amount of SRTS funds available. The preference for implementing projects under a LAP contract is a FDOT District 1 policy as opposed to a Central Office Tallahassee policy. FDOT reason was that it costs more money for the State to build the project plus it takes the State longer to complete the project. It takes three years to complete the project for the State but under a LAP contract it only takes 1-2 years. Through these and follow up questions staff tried to get a definitive answer if there would be any penalties to an application during project evaluation if Lee County BOCC (which is LAP certified) ask FDOT to manage the project. Or for that matter if the request is made in an application by a municipality in Lee County which is not LAP certified. Telephone conversation with District 1 staff indicated that the applications may score negatively but they were reluctant to provide this in writing.

Mr. Scott explained that MPO was already receiving questions about projects that may be funded with TA funds, and why the County was not doing these projects under a LAP contract. This is happening in Collier as well. There is a whole long list of reasons. If it is FDOT's own project they add inflation factors but for the longest time usually local jurisdictions could build it cheaper but now the project costs are getting closer and closer. Where no inflation is taken into account in a project there are contingency funds but it has been observed that there is a difference in contingency between the FDOT project and the LAP project. Some of this seems like a convenient excuse of they are too busy, they want the project done but don't want to do it. But if they are looking at a list of projects and Agency A will do the project but Agency B wants FDOT to do the project, it is something that will affect the project getting funding. The MPO is having a bigger discussion about this amongst the other counties, identifying the issues that we are all dealing with, but it isn't being resolved very quickly at the moment.

The second discussion point was the amount of funds available for this year's funding cycle. SRTS dollars are based on student population in a district. Basically 14% of State student population is in District 1. They have already programmed some of the SRTS funds in upcoming years. Mr. Gogoi showed a slide of the projects currently programmed in District 1 for FYs 2016 through FY 2021. He

reported that the Statewide SRTS Coordinator informed him that \$980,000 in FY 2020, and another \$980,000 in FY 2021 are available to District 1. There will be no funds for District 1 in FY 2022 as FDOT have set aside \$1,000,000 for the implementation of the Tice Sidewalks. Central office will fund projects over and beyond funds designated to a particular District. Lee County is being encouraged to submit as many applications as possible because other Districts in Florida may not apply and FDOT may then use their funds to program projects in District 1. They may even award projects for 2023 and 2024 during the 2016 funding cycle. Lee County gets more SRTS funds than any other county in District 1.

There was also a discussion of school sidewalk needs with local governments reporting the potential projects for which they would desire the school district to prepare applications. Ron asked around the table, starting with Sean Gibbons from Bonita Springs, if there were needs for the funds. Mr. Gibbons stated that Bonita Springs has many projects already in progress and are holding off and not committing as to not take away funding from anyone else. Doug Saxton suggested sidewalk extensions on both sides of River Ranch Road between Corkscrew and Williams.

There was also discussion about SW 25<sup>th</sup> Street and connecting that to Harns Marsh Elementary and Middle School in Lehigh. Mr. Karakos from the City of Fort Myers suggested resubmitting the Clifford sidewalk project at Edison Park Elementary, possibly Llewellyn from US 41 to Cortez with Fort Myers High and Edison Park in close proximity, and Nuna Avenue by Tice Elementary after drainage/right of way are reviewed. Three Oaks Elementary at Cypress View Drive was also suggested.

Ms. Huff stated that the School District would submit 2 to 3 projects for SRTS funds for the 2016 funding cycle. One of the projects could be the Clifford sidewalk project. The signatures in the original application would need to be changed but everything else could be submitted the same way, unless the cost had changed. Another project could be SW 25th Street sidewalk at Harns Marsh Elementary and Middle in Lehigh Acres. She also presented a list of schools with hazardous walking conditions which could be potential projects for SRTS funds. A Gladiolus/Winkler project was suggested but the committee determined that there is a newer path there. Next, a project on Littleton Road was suggested but ditches and right of way constraints may make it unfeasible. A Lehigh Acres project at Mirror Lakes Elementary involving two small bridges was discussed and would need two sidewalks which might be expensive. There was another project involving a bridge around Coolidge and Lee Boulevard in Lehigh with segments involved in a current project. The final project, another bridge, in Cape Coral along the south side of Veterans involves five schools and adding sidewalks near the bridge but may be a current/proposed Cape Coral City project.

### Agenda Item #4 - John Hopkins All Children's School SRTS Community Program Update

Mr. Marinack stated that the SRTS Community Program led by the Johns Hopkins All Children's Hospital instructs parents, children, educators, and administrators on how to improve bicycling and walking routes to and from school through Pedestrian and Bike Safety Curriculum, Walking School Bus, Bike Rodeo, Community Events, International Walk to School Day, and National Bike to School Day. They primarily work with K-5 but have a small program for 6<sup>th</sup> grade and middle schools as well. They work with the school PE teachers in conjunction with the Sunshine Standards which include bicycle and pedestrian safety. Last year they serviced 8 counties and this year they have 16 counties with the same personnel. They are grant funded through the state.

#### Agenda Item #5 - TIGER and Other MPO Project Updates/Developments

Mr. Scott provided an update on the TIGER project. Colonial shared use path is completed. Drainage work is going on in Daniels Parkway and a second bridge is being installed. Eighty-nine percent of contract time lapsed with eighty-two percent of the money spent. Tiger wayfinding working group met about two weeks ago and the next step is to determine signage costs and maintenance agreements.

There was also discussion about the video/pictures taken for publicity and drones used for filming. The MPO Roundabout Study completed the 30% design plans for the Sanibel Causeway/Periwinkle and McGregor Boulevard/Colonial intersections. Cape Coral Bike Ped Master Plan final plan will be presented in late fall to City Council. Jacobs and Alta were selected for doing the Fort Myers Beach Bike Ped Master Plan.

### Agenda Item #6 - Local Government Reports on Bicycle Pedestrian Related Projects

Mr. Gibbons reported that the City of Bonita Springs just approved Bike Ped Master Plan. There are detours on US 41 due to construction on downtown.

Mr. Saxton reported that Estero Parkway negotiations between the Village of Estero and the County was completed. Mr. Karakos felt that the Village should push developer for a roundabout before Bella Terra at Wild Blue.

Mr. Getch asked that the committee bylaws be amended to reflect that the Lee County Community Development be added to the membership in place of LCDOT. Request made to be added to next meeting agenda.

Mr. Karakos reported that the City of Fort Myers is doing the Edison Avenue realignment. The roundabout at Virginia/McGregor may be moved up to the McGregor drainage project timetable.

FDOT has just published the **attached** draft tentative Work Program covering fiscal years 2018 through 2022, and the document is currently going through an ePublic Hearing which will end on October 24<sup>th</sup> (also **attached** is the additions, re-schedulings and deletions table). Comments on the document will be accepted by FDOT if received by Monday, October 31<sup>st</sup>.

At the October 25<sup>th</sup> BPCC meeting, FDOT will present the draft work program with the primary focus on new bicycle pedestrian projects and project phases in the work program which have been added on the basis of SRTS priorities adopted by the Lee County MPO Board at its March 18<sup>th</sup> meeting, Sun Trail priorities adopted at its April 22<sup>nd</sup> meeting, and TA and SU funded bicycle pedestrian priorities adopted at its August 19<sup>th</sup> meeting.

FDOT is still working on some additional bike ped projects and project phases for inclusion in the work program. These additional projects will be reported at the October 25<sup>th</sup> meeting. Analysis of the work program in the context of the adopted bike ped priorities and actual projects programmed will be shared at the meeting.

### PRESENTATION OF THE CAPE CORAL BIKE PED MASTER PLAN

**ACTION ITEM:** This is not an action item. Alta Planning and Jacobs will provide a presentation on the Cape Coral Bike Ped Master Plan.

Guided by a Project Advisory Committee, the MPO's consultant Alta Planning + Design Inc., and Jacobs have been working on a bicycle pedestrian master plan for the City of Cape Coral since the beginning of the year. The consultant has developed a draft final report which is currently being finalized. The finalized report will be presented to the Cape City Council for acceptance at its November 2<sup>nd</sup> meeting. The document is not yet ready for review by the BPCC, but the final accepted report will be distributed to the committee after Council acceptance. However, the Oct 25<sup>th</sup> presentation will highlight the salient features of the Report.

# PRESENTATION ON THE US 41 CORRIDOR IMPROVEMENTS IN FORT MYERS

#### **DISCUSSION ITEM:**

The FDOT corridor improvement project is located along Cleveland Ave (US 41) from Winkler Avenue to just south of SR 82. This project incorporates safety and restoration enhancements intended to extend the life of the roadway and drainage systems while improving pedestrian and vehicular safety. Safety improvements include construction of a raised median, six mid-block pedestrian crossings with overhead mounted pedestrian traffic control devices, new and upgraded signals at select intersections, lighting upgrades, and new signing and pavement markings. In addition, the extension of the dual box culvert at Canal Street will provide additional room for pedestrian connectivity and increase safety for road users. Driveways and curb ramps will be replaced where practical to bring the corridor in compliance with current ADA standards. The City of Fort Myers is also designing the replacement of utility systems along the corridor which will be constructed along with the roadway improvements.

At the request of the City of Fort Myers, when construction is complete a "road diet" test will be conducted by FDOT for approximately two months. The test will consist of a temporary lane closure of the inside travel lanes for both northbound and southbound directions from Canal St. to Victoria Ave. This will help to assess the feasibility of a future road diet design option and evaluate the impact of a reduction in travel lanes to the roadway's level of service and the associated impact of traffic diverted to the City's network of parallel reliever roadways.

# DISCUSSION ON LEE COUNTY UPDATE TO FGT'S PRIORITY TRAIL NETWORK

**DISCUSSION ITEM:** Discuss staff proposal for adding trail corridors/individual trails to the FGT Priority Trail Map.

The Office of Greenways and Trails (OGT) is updating the Florida Greenways and Trails System (FGTS) Plan, and the Opportunity and Priority Maps. See **attached** email. Priority trails automatically make its way to the Florida Sun Trail network so the update is critical to Lee County to ensure that our high priority trail corridors from the 2040 Bike Ped Element are added to the Land Trails Priority Map, and we make a strong play for more SUN Trail funds to the area. The new individual trails that will benefit by any addition to the Land Trails Priority Map will be the Pine Island Trail which has a PD&E Study scheduled for 2020, and the Able Canal Multi Use Trail which has a PD&E Study currently under way.

Fortunately for us, we are a little ahead in this exercise as compared to other Florida counties because if you recall we had actually started this exercise over a year ago, and we had several discussions at BPCC meetings, which all culminated with staff making a request to FGT to add our additional identified corridors to the priority map. We were told by FGT then to wait until they start the process to update the Priority Trail Map. We have to vet this again through the BPCC to ensure we have consensus before staff resubmits the request.

The Office of Greenways and Trails (OGT) is updating the Florida Greenways and Trails System (FGTS) Plan, and the Opportunity and Priority Maps. OGT is seeking your input!

The FGTS Plan establishes the vision for implementing a connected statewide system of greenways and trails for recreation, conservation, alternative transportation, healthy lifestyles, a vibrant economy and a high quality of life. The original FGTS Plan was completed in 1998 and adopted by the Florida Legislature in 1999, laying the groundwork for many programs, projects and initiatives which exist today. The FGTS Plan and Priority Maps were last updated in 2012 and the visioning maps (Opportunity Maps) updated in 2015. The updated FGTS Plan and maps will guide implementation of the connected statewide trail system from 2018 through 2022. Keep tabs on the update process through the OGT FGTS Update Page.

The FGTS Plan and maps are being updated in 2016 through 2017. The OGT is reaching out to you and others involved in trail planning to receive input on both the Opportunity and Priority land and paddling trail maps. The FGTS Plan ties together the local, regional and state plans and collaborative efforts for greenways and trails, bicycle and pedestrian, master plans and other plans of communities, agencies and non-profits throughout Florida to create three levels of FGTS maps:

- Level 1 The Vision: Land Trail and Paddling Trail Opportunity Maps.
- Level 2 Priority Trails Map: The spine of a statewide system identified from the Opportunity Maps and the Florida Ecological Greenways Network Map.
- Level 3 Priority Trails Status: Each corridor's status is identified as existing, gap, or programmed/funded. The needs of each segment are identified as acquisition or maintenance, including repaving.

For each Opportunity and Priority Trail corridor, we need to verify the corridor's alignment and make a determination whether the corridor should be **kept**, **modified or deleted**. Additionally, we would like to obtain information on the status of each corridor (**existing**, **gap**, **or programmed/funded**) and the need (**acquisition or maintenance**, **including repaying etc**.)

To assist in this effort, please utilize one of the tools below:

- 1. Look at the 2012 Priority Maps and 2015 Opportunity Maps interactively through FDEP's Map Direct Gallery. Help documents for this tool are available by clicking on the "?" button that appears at the top of the Map Direct window in your web browser.
