The image of the statewide SUN Trail (fpn 429823-1) is at a school crossing.

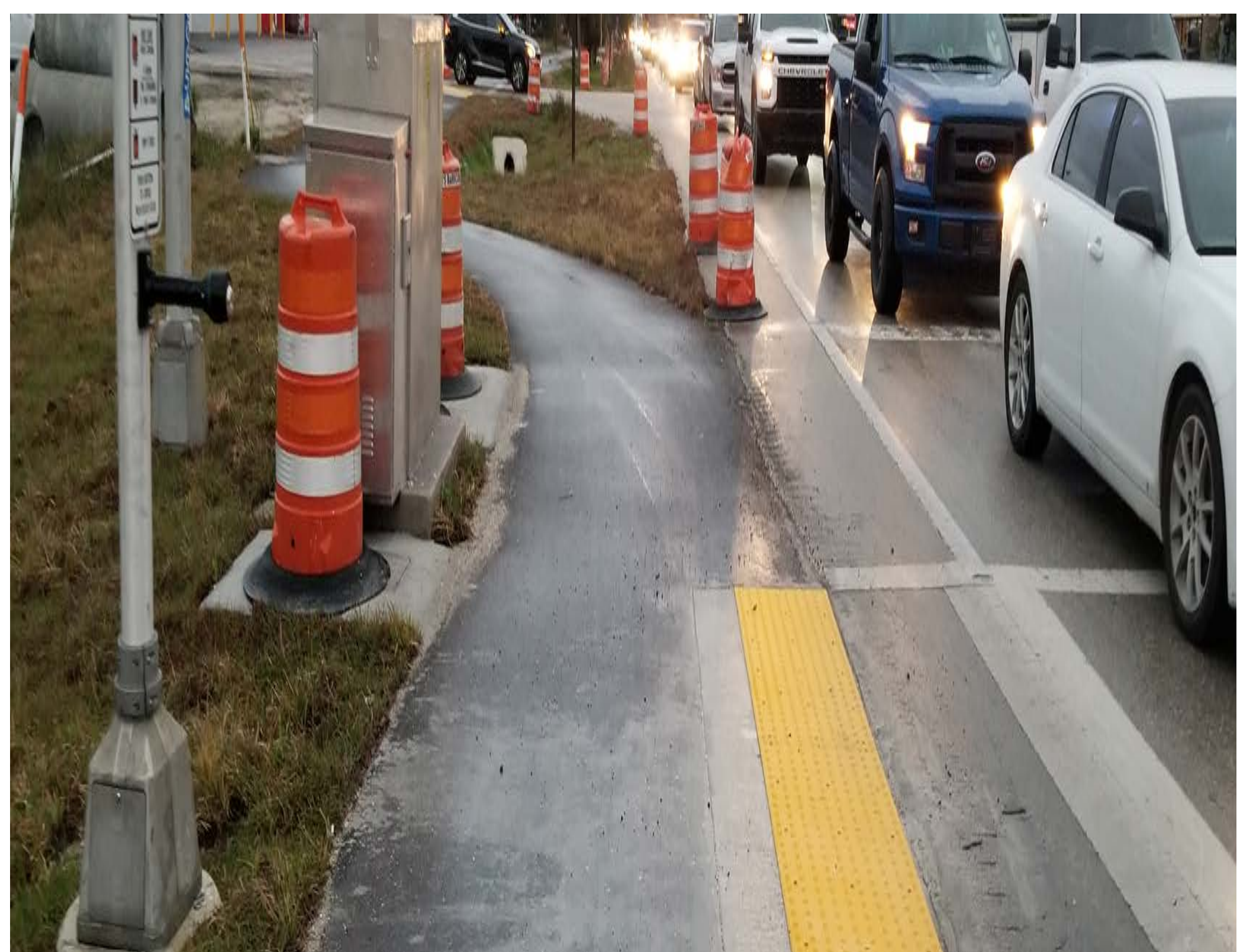

Dear BPCC Chair,

You may not remember my previous offer since I was only allowed three minutes before Mr. Gogoi intervened.

I provided Mr. Gogoi a PowerPoint presentation that I spoke to during the BPCC meeting. If you cannot locate my public comment I can provide you a copy.

I offered to fund a concrete box culvert so the alignment of this section of the Statewide SUN Trail Network (Image 1) could be shifted away from the roadway so children waiting at the school crossing would not be forced to compete with cyclists and pedestrians all within a non-conforming 8' wide section of the SUN Trail abutting SR 80.

Please ask the committee to reconsider supporting my offer.
