## **Meeting Minutes**

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### **Agenda Item #1 - Call to Order**

Vice-Chair Carl Karakos called the meeting to order at approximately 10:03 a.m.

### **Agenda Item #2 - Roll Call/Introductions**

The committee members introduced themselves. Roll was recorded by MPO staff. There was a quorum.

Others in attendance included: Ron Gogoi, Don Scott, and Brian Raimondo with the Lee County MPO; Michelle Peronto, Patrick Bateman, Charlene Ross, and Steven Davis with FDOT; and Arlinda Karuli with Commute with Enterprise.

### **Agenda Item #3 - Public Comments on Items on the Agenda**

There were no public comments on items on the agenda.

### **Agenda Item #4 – Approval of March 8, 2023 Meeting Minutes**

**Mr. Mike Cook made the motion to approve the March 8, 2023 Meeting Minutes. Ms. Teresa Lewis seconded the motion. There were no objections, and the motion passed unanimously.**

### **Agenda Item #5 - \*Approval of the Scope for SS4A funded Countywide Safety Action Plan**

Mr. Don Scott gave a summary of the tasks in the scope of the Vision Zero Safety Action Plan. He mentioned that MPO Planning funds may be used to complete the public involvement tasks to allow all the grant funds to be spent on the crash analysis and development of strategies, projects and programs.

The project completion date is March 31, 2025 but it could be completed earlier. In response to a call for comments, Mr. David Williams suggested adding driver behavior to the list of contributing factors that will be used in the crash analysis. In response to questions Mr. Scott clarified that the project would be advertised to select a consulting team made up of a primary consultant and subs, that projects coming out from this Plan must have support from the local governments, and that local governments would be responsible for implementation of the projects within their jurisdiction, and that they can tap into implementation grants which would require a local match. Public outreach as part of this project could piggyback on a local government's public involvement events for an ongoing project.

The scope was included in the agenda packet, [posted to the MPO website](#), and pulled up for viewing at the meeting.

**Mr. David Willems made the motion to approve Safe Streets for All Scope. Mr. Mike Cook seconded the motion. There were no objections, and the motion passed unanimously.**

### **Agenda Item #6 - District One Van Pool Program Update**

Ms. Michelle Peronto, with FDOT, and Ms. Arlinda Karuli, with Commute with Enterprise, provided an overview of the FDOT District One Commute Connector and Van Pool Program. Ms. Terry Lewis commented that twice as many women in Lee county did not own cars than men and they had child responsibility and she asked how could van pool program help transporting kids to school. Ms. Peronto mentioned that it would not work for everyone, but a van pool could accommodate a child if the mother is the designated driver and as long as the child did not take the seat of a participant. She also mentioned the MacDill Air Base which has a childcare facility for the employees. To a question on CDL requirements and incentivizing individual drivers who is getting paid to drive 3 people to leave their older vehicles and use the new vehicles from the van pool program, Ms. Peronto replied that the biggest vehicle is a 15 passenger van, and a driver did not require a CDL license, only a 5 year US license with no more than 3 moving violations. They had been turned away by some businesses because they paid a driver to drive employees and that it was a side business for them, and that they had more luck with companies where a person is willing to drive for the group because the driver gets a new SUV, can take it home, and use it for 200 miles of personal use. She also mentioned that reporting van pool data to FTA generates Section 5307 funds and that for the first time Section 5307 apportionments of Florida transit agencies in FY 2024 have actually seen an increase because of it. Leetran is the beneficiary of van pool data in Lee County. The van pool program update presentation can be viewed at the following link: [District One Van Pool](#).

### **Agenda Item #7 – ATMS and Signal Preemption Updates**

Ms. Jillian Schiller, with Lee County DOT, provided an overview of the planned ATMS Phase III and provided an updated cost estimate. To a question by Mr. Al O'Donnell she replied that the County prefers owning and not sharing fiber optic cables to protect against threats to cybersecurity such as hacking into the traffic signals and Dynamic Message Signs. Mr. Gogoi reported that MPO staff will be funding the design phase in FY 2029 with Carbon Reduction Program funds. That would allow the County to advance local funds and complete the design sooner and then recoup the funds in FY 2029.

Ms. Schiller also provided an overview of the proposed Countywide Signal Preemption in Lee County using Centracs Priority Software. Existing pre-emption system do not support transit signal priority and uses Opticom at select intersections to force green phase for emergency vehicles from the Iona McGregor and South Trail Fire Districts. Back to back pre-emptions can knock signals out of coordination in a busy corridor like Daniels by as much as 30 minutes causing heavy congestion. She then went on to explain the merits of the Centracs Priority which is a systemwide pre-emption and stated that the County can build the system in phases. To question from Al O' Donnell, Ms. Schiller replied that

In consideration of time, Mr. Gogoi asked to move to Mr. Patrick Bateman's Agenda Item #8, and then return to the second half of Agenda Item #7, FRAME updates from FDOT's Steven Davis. Those in attendance agreed by consensus to this agenda change.

### **Agenda Item #8 - Presentation on the SR 78/Bayshore Road Capacity Study**

Mr. Patrick Bateman, with FDOT, presented the SR 31 and SR 78/Bayshore Road Capacity Study. He explained the proposed improvements to the SR 80 and SR 31 intersection which includes a EB and SB left turn flyovers facilitated by a crossover signal to the north. Left turns at the intersection are only allowed for entering Publix. He also explained the traffic control devices and their alternates being considered at various intersections along the corridor including conventional traffic signal, Partial Displaced Left Turn, Continuous Green T, MUT, Thru Cut and roundabouts where there were 2 and 3 lanes only. ### **Agenda Item #7 continued – FRAME Updates**

Mr. Steven Davis, with FDOT, provided an update and overview of the Lee County FRAME project. Project includes cabinet equipment upgrades and installation of radio devices and LIDAR at 25 US 41 intersections to facilitate communication between Connected Vehicles (CV). LIDAR assists in detection of pedestrians within the intersections which is then communicated to CVs. The project limit is from North Airport Road to Pine Island Road. Construction is under way. Target installation completion in September, and system will be fully operational by end of year. Transit Signal Priority will follow FRAME deployment with the addition of minimum equipment including On Board Units (OBU) in Leetran buses.

Ms. Susan Drotleff enquired about the radio frequency of OBUs in CVs and whether they will interfere with transponders in the vehicles used for toll collection. Mr. Davis stated that radio frequencies could be calibrated to minimize the interference. Ms. Scholler commented that transponders and CV units may be actually required to operate at different frequencies. To a question on aftermarket cost of OBUs to retrofit a non CV, Mr. David said they cost around \$5,000. There is also labor cost for integrating the unit to a vehicle's internal computer and diagnostic system, and adding antennae, but cost are expected to drop when OEMs start building more and more cars with OBUs.

Mr. Davis also provided an overview and update of the Wrong Way Driver Detection project. The countermeasures are already in place in some of the locations in Lee and Collier County. Some have only the monitoring cameras while the rest have both the cameras and flashing signs. His presentation can be viewed at the following link: [FRAME Updates](#). ### **INFORMATION ITEM:**

A design build project is under way to add an 8' wide sidewalk on the west side of the Caloosahatchee Bridge in Downtown Fort Myers. The project will also add a sidewalk on the west side of US 41 from the north end of the bridge to south of North Shore Park in North Fort Myers. The southern terminus of the project is West First Street along the Loop Ramp. Early concepts and options for the bike ped facility were presented previously at various BPCC meetings by MPO staff. Joe Lauk, PM for this project, will provide a presentation at the November 8<sup>th</sup> TMOOC meeting.

## **CALOOSAHATCHEE BRIDGE TRANSPORTATION PLAN**

### **INFORMATION ITEM:**

The construction of the Caloosahatchee Bridge Sidewalk and median modification will involve lane closures during the day during off peak season (May through November) and nighttime lane closures only (December through April). Lane closures will utilize the FDOT Smart Zone concept. At the November 8<sup>th</sup> TMOOC Meeting, Neal Turner-TSMO Arterial Engineer with FDOT will provide a presentation on the operation of the Smart Plan Concept during the construction of the sidewalk project.

## **CAPE CORAL HIGHWAY SAFETY AND HVE GRANT UPDATE**

### **INFORMATION AND DISCUSSION ITEM:**

At the November 8<sup>th</sup> TMOG meeting, Master Sergeant Alisha Cody will provide an update on the various tasks completed as part of the *Impaired Driving* and *Speed/Aggressive Driving* Highway Safety Sub Grants that the City of Cape Coral received for the 2022-2023 grant cycle. The grant period covered December 1, 2022 through September 30, 2023.

Cape PD has been applying for these and the Distracted Driving Highway Safety Sub Grants as well as the High Visibility Enforcement (HVE) for *Pedestrian and Bicycle Safety*. They have applied for all 4 grants for the 2023 – 2024 grant cycle. LCSO is the other law enforcement agency in Lee County which used to regularly apply and receive these grant funds.

## **PRESENTATION ON THE SR 78 CORRIDOR VISION & ACTION PLAN**

### **DISCUSSION ITEM:**

The FDOT staff and their consultants have recently completed a Corridor Vision & Action Plan for SR 78 from Burnt Store Road to US 41. The study began in April of 2022 and the plan outlines the goals and potential strategies to guide transportation and land use decisions by the City of Cape Coral, Lee County, and Lee County MPO over the next 50 years. MPO staff will present the results of the study and the next steps.
